Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine store hiring just 4 individuals. Total sales for that particular year totaled 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and various parts. Within five years of operation, the company had stretched to 40 workers and their annual sales volume had risen to 330 thousand dollars. These days, Cascade is amongst the leading worldwide producers within the material handling industry.

Manufacture and design of the company's original hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of better business opportunities. Over the last sixty years, the material handling business has developed into a highly sophisticated area and Cascade has proudly played a part on this progress. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the best provider of lift truck attachments and various related products. The business feels assured in their capability in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding buyer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive in the global market.

Through the 1950's, Cascade began to manufacture, design, and sell its hydraulic accessories. A brand new facility was built in the year 1956, to house all the plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's current center of operations. Subsequent to fifteen years of business, total workers reached 180 employees and sales had reached practically two million three hundred thousand dollars.

A second production plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Burbank. The year 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary move into the global world of the material handling industry when the business established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In 1964, the company altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in 1965, the business went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing amenities throughout the continental US to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Burbank. Cascade products are made globally thanks to many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This facility is designed to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 after buying five firms, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global best in blades.
